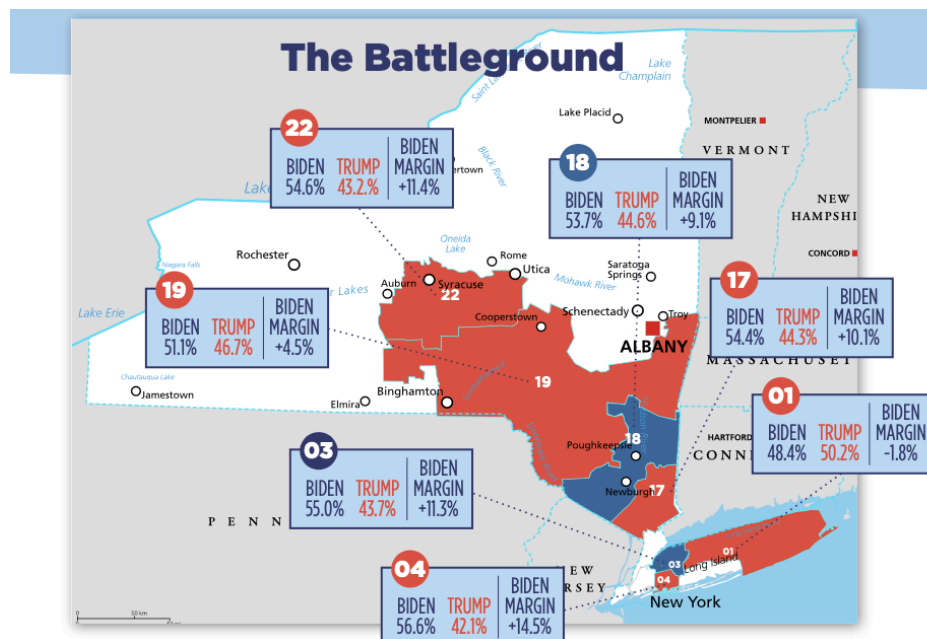
## OVERVIEW

The path to the U.S. House majority runs through the Empire State, and this November, the New York State Democratic Party (NY Dems) will lead the charge to turn the House blue. NY Dems have launched a Coordinated Campaign to protect our **two swing-seat Democratic incumbents** and **flip five Republican-held seats**. Democrats can reclaim the House majority by winning these seats alone. With fewer than **100 days until Election Day**, we are confident that this statewide effort will be instrumental in securing victory.

Governor Kathy Hochul, Leader Hakeem Jeffries, Senator Kirsten Gillibrand and Chairman Jay Jacobs are spearheading an **unprecedented coordinated campaign** that focuses on vital field efforts to recruit, train, and deploy volunteers and organizers to support campaigns and turn out voters for Democrats up and down the ballot.

In the 2023 off-year elections, New York Democrats made extraordinary gains down-ballot, successfully flipping seats from red to blue within competitive Congressional districts. In the February special election in NY-03, NY Dems provided on-the-ground support for Tom Suozzi's successful campaign to flip the Republican-held seat blue.

The Coordinated Campaign is an **over \$5 million effort** and will have over **80 staff** hired on the ground by mid-August and **35 field offices** opened statewide.



## STAFFING UP

Over four months out from the 2024 elections, NY Dems have already hired **65 coordinated campaign staff**, including field organizers, college/youth organizers, fellows and HQ staff.

The NY Dems are continuing to hire field staff. By mid-August, we will have over **80** coordinated campaign staff, with more than **50** turfed field organizers throughout the state.

**PROGRAMMING**

Constituency Organizing Program

The Constituency Outreach Program is a concerted effort to galvanize residents across diverse constituencies to increase voter participation. This initiative connects local Democratic candidates with communities that often feel marginalized by the political process, devoting ample time and effort to building trust through year-round engagement. The Statewide Engagement Director oversees the work of Constituency Organizers in competitive districts and works to develop strong ties to the AAPI, Muslim, African American/Black, Hispanic, and Jewish Communities.

Distributed Program

The distributed program coordinates with New York City and other out-of-district grassroots groups, as well as individual activists who want to support efforts in our targeted competitive districts. The team is working with over **30 grassroots groups, NYC political clubs, elected officials, and county parties** across the state to mobilize their members and volunteers, ensuring resources are effectively organized.

Partnership with Legislative Committees

Coordinated staff are working side by side with the New York State Senate (DSCC) and Assembly Campaign Committees (DACC) to ensure mutual success for Democrats up and down the ballot.

Alongside our allies and partners in organized labor:

- Over **3,000** individual volunteers
- Many of these programs represent the **largest July voter contact efforts** for any congressional in the county.
- Total number of voter contacts: **118,427**
  - Statewide doors knocked in July so far: 25,504
  - Statewide doors knocked since March: 52,732
  - Statewide calls made since March: 65,695
- Our program plans to contact nearly **1 million** voters by Election Day.

## **100 DAYS TO GO**

Since Summer 2023, NY Dems have deployed staff and volunteers who are working tirelessly to flip seats from Long Island to the Hudson Valley to Central New York and beyond. Momentum is on our side — we will continue to work around the clock to elect Democrats from Vice President Harris on down, take back the House and make Hakeem Jeffries Speaker, and deliver for New Yorkers in every corner of the state.
